I was 2 years old. I would like to thank you

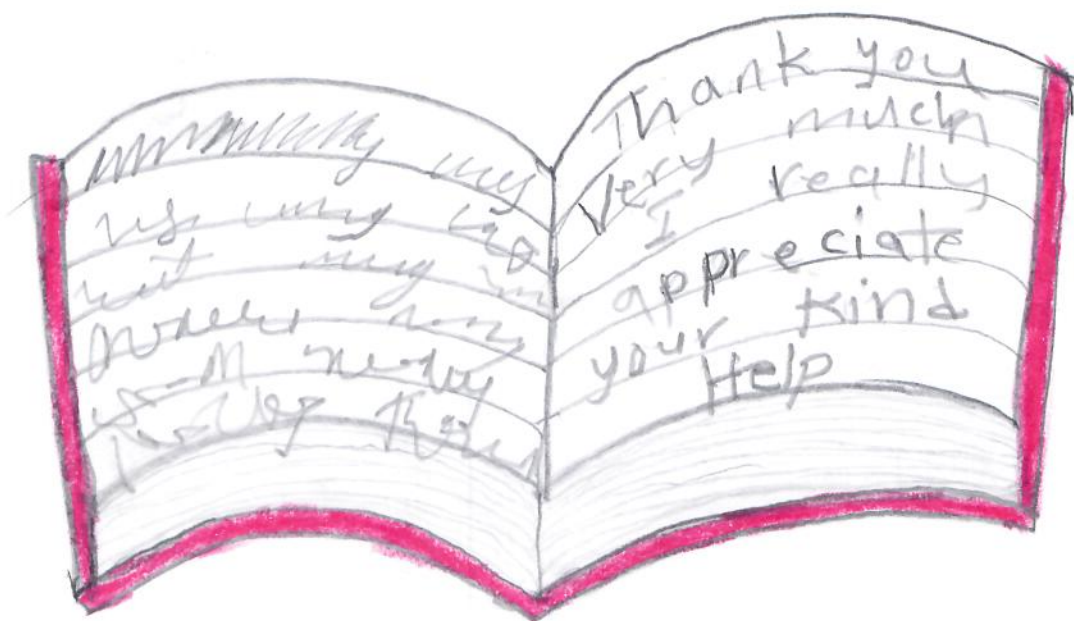
Very much for paying my school

How are you doing?

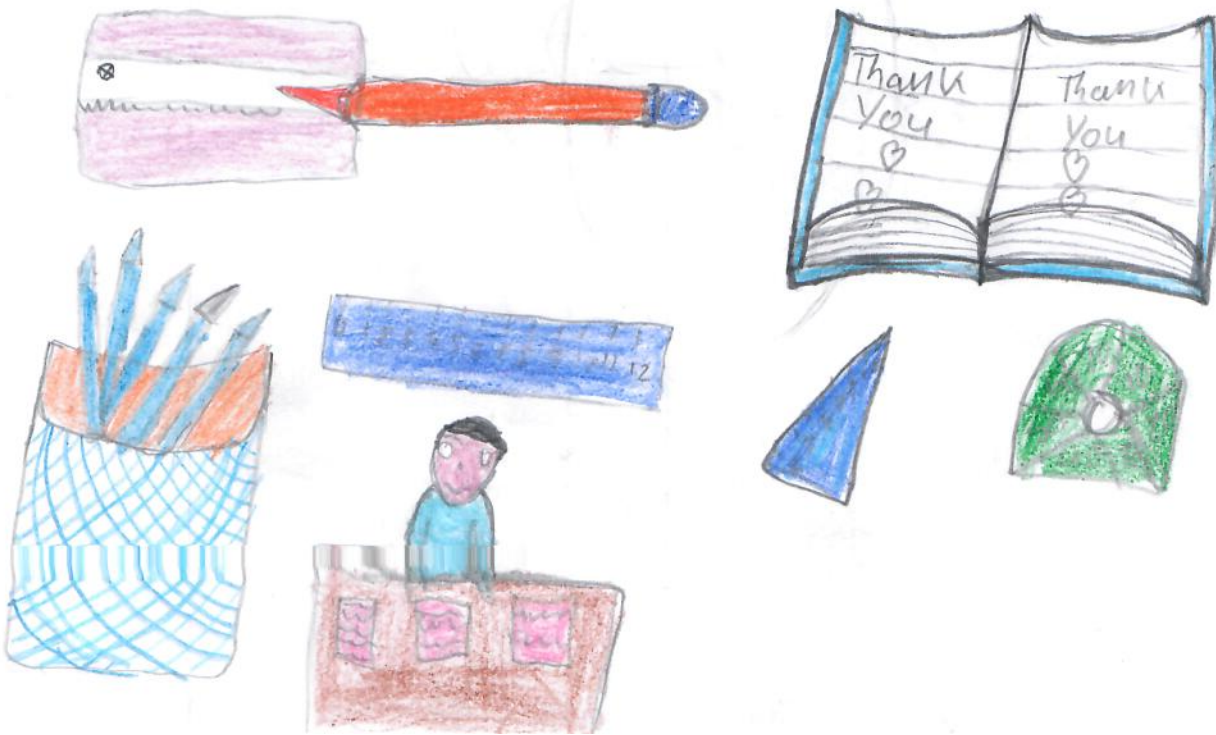
My name is Abdou.
